The countdown to the opening of Tesco Yardley is underway. With 80,000 sq metres of new retail space including a new Extra supermarket and 20 retail units creating over 300 new jobs, this is another exciting development for Birmingham.

There will be 2 'pathways' for people to try and access jobs at the new Tesco store:

Pathway 1: The Partnership Pathway

This Pathway is designed to support individuals who are currently **unemployed**. Interested candidates will need to...

- Step 1: Telephone the Hotline and register for one of the Assessment Days
- Step 2: Attend one of five Assessment Days (17 to 21 October) by invitation only
- Step 3: If successful, attend a first impressions interview with Tesco (24 October to 11 November)
- Step 4: If successful, attend all Pre-Employment Training (21 November to 16 December)
- Step 5: If successful, job start will be in January

(NB: Dates are provisional at this stage)

Important Notes:

- A) Please prepare local candidates for the above.
- B) Assessment Days will assess candidates for literacy & numeracy skills and readiness for first impressions interview with Tesco.
- C) Candidates must be available for all of the Pre Employment Training and have a flexible approach to working.
- D) We encourage you to support candidates from BCC's 'Priority Areas'.
- E) DETAILS of the Hotline and Assessment Days will be provided in another briefing very soon.
